1. Computer Systems:

- Basic definition of computer, features and applications, hardware, software, firmware and liveware. Representation of information inside a computer.
- Generation of Computers – classification of computers according to purpose (general and special purpose), according to working (analog, digital and hybrid), according to processing capability (Super, mainframe, mini, micro, laptop and palmtop).
- Block diagram of a Computer system – Standard and common input/output devices.
- Processing – CPU, ALU, CU Memory, unit and different types Bit, byte, kilobyte, megabyte and Gigabyte. Semiconductor memories such as ROM, RAM, PROM, EPROM, EEPROM.

2. Operating Systems:

- Secondary storage devices – NTFS, Latest removable storage devices, hard disk and pendrives.
